The TAEL-led renovation of the University of Illinois at Chicago / University of Illinois Hospital Pharmacy Clean Room Suite achieved substantial completion in May, 2017. Equipment in all the functional spaces has been installed, and operation within the suite reflects the needed improvements that brought the project about.

The project entailed renovating the University of Illinois Hospital Pharmacy Clean Room Suite, located in the concourse of the main hospital building. The completed installation complies with ISO 5000, as well as with USP 797 and USP 800.

The functional program included a Gowning area, an Anteroom, an Aseptic room, a Chemo room, and a Walk-in Refrigerator/Freezer. The general aspects of the project included gutting the entire suite, reconfiguring the layout to optimize the functional relationship of the requirements, increasing visual communication between rooms and providing new finishes and equipment.

The project also included a new dedicated exhaust system for the Chemo Hood, new lighting, receptical and equipment power, along with new voice/data outlets, cameras, and intercom.

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UIC COM 5th Floor Renovation -

TAEL has been awarded the College of Medicine (COM) 5th Floor Renovation project in Building 908. The project entails reconfiguring the entire floor (approximately 5,600 square feet) to create a new reception suite for COM's administrative departments. The programmatic requirements include private offices, open workstations, conference rooms, kitchenette / lunchroom and other support functions. As part of this project, all the MEP systems, as well as IT, will be upgraded. Currently, the design development stage is nearly completed and functional layout has been approved. It is estimated that the construction may take one year subsequent to approved bidding documents. The time also includes ordering, delivery and installation of new furniture.

As a member of the EXP, U.S. Services, Inc. Team, TAEL has been selected to provide CAD Librarian services to support AT&T design and construction activities in its Northeastern Region. The two principal functions of this position entail recording/updating construction documents and preparing existing drawing packages for new design and construction activities. Part of TAEL's responsibility also includes converting existing building data to a new electronic storage system that enhances the refinement of drawings and facilitates document correlation of multi-discipline sets.
